VAT Information

Below we include useful VAT information to support you in understanding when and how to make use of our VAT Certificate of Declaration Form, what to consider and how to contact us if you have any related questions.

How to claim 5% VAT for eligible domestic or charitable non-business use:

How to claim 5% VAT If you wish to submit a claim for any domestic or charitable non-business use that is eligible for 5% VAT (this is known as qualifying use) please:

- (i) Complete the separate VAT Certificate of Declaration Form included in at the back of this booklet
- (ii) Provide brief details about the basis of your claim and the effective date for the claim, or enclose a separate covering letter detailing that information when returning the VAT Certificate of Declaration Form to us
- (iii) Send back the completed VAT Certificate of Declaration Form (with a covering letter if appropriate) to the email or postal address quoted on the form. Once accepted, the corresponding qualifying use percentage will be applied to your account. If for any reason your circumstances change, you should notify us by submitting a new VAT Certificate of Declaration Form

Important points to remember:

- The percentage claimed should be to the nearest whole number
- The percentage of 'qualifying' use must be your own estimate
- You should try to apportion the amount of electricity used for heating, lighting, appliances etc. between 'qualifying' domestic or charitable non-business use and 'nonqualifying' business use

Where the claim is for 60% or more qualifying domestic or charitable non-business use, all of the supply, including that used for business purposes, will be charged at the reduced VAT rate, currently 5%. Your claim should, however, reflect the actual percentage of 'qualifying' use only.

You must be able to demonstrate to HM Revenue & Customs (HMRC) if required, that the electricity on which you are claiming the 5% reduced rate of VAT is for qualifying use. A false statement or failure to advise us of any significant change in your circumstances may make you liable to a financial penalty under Paragraph 101 of the Finance Act 2000 and/or the Value Added Tax Act (as amended from time to time).

Business use in line with current legislation:

If your electricity is used solely for business purposes, VAT will usually be charged at the standard rate. Climate Change Levy (CCL) where applicable and VAT on the CCL will also be added to the bill.

Business and small quantities use:

If the average business use during the billing period does not exceed 33 kWh per day (1,000 kWh per month) of electricity at one premise, it is considered to be domestic use for VAT purposes and VAT is chargeable at the reduced rate of 5%.

This concession is applied automatically at the time of billing and there is no need for the customer to complete a certificate in order to claim 5% VAT on low business usage. Any supply that attracts 5% VAT,

is also automatically excluded from CCL. The small quantities criteria is applied as explained above, regardless of whether the bill is based on actual meter consumption or an estimate.

Charities:

There is no general relief from VAT for charities and the registration of a charity does not automatically qualify it for the reduced rate of VAT on electricity supplies. If however, the supply is used wholly or partly for charitable non-business or domestic use, the legislation does provide specific relief whereby that part of the supply qualifies for the 5% reduced rate of VAT.

For more details on the application of the reduced rate of VAT please refer to VAT Notice 701/19 on fuel and power.
